Art Nouveau Lace (PM)

This bobbin lace course is based on the antique tiles of England, Belgium and Germany that were created during the Art Nouveau movement 1890-1910. These tapes and free form floral laces incorporate the varied techniques of layering, blending and shading of color, beginnings and endings, fillings, and the use of Mirecourt cord while re-creating the elegant flowing lines of this art form. Students will choose from one of three designs drafted from authentic antique tiles to be worked in silk in the appropriate colors of this era. Students should have basic bobbin lace skills in this intermediate level course. A set of silks will be available from the instructor for \$25.00.
