**Beginning Bobbin Lace (AM)**

12-hour class

Teacher: Sylvie Nguyen

Learn and explore the traditional art of bobbin lace making. The introductory basic skills will be taught, with an emphasis placed on tape lace. Begin with a tape lace sampler, and then continue by making a bookmark, bracelet, or ornament. A brief history of bobbin lace, as well as some of the contemporary applications will be discussed. Intended course level: beginner.

Materials needed: cookie pillow, long silk pins, 12 pairs of bobbins, tatting cotton size 80 and size 30 cotton, scissors, size 14 crochet hook, cover cloth, clear contact paper, several glass-headed pins.
