Filet Lace is embroidery made on a fine knotted net using a long blunt needle. Filet Guipure is a collection of fancy stitches and use of different size of thread to form a delicate lace. Would it be for "scrapbooking" a special page, for your big book of genealogy, or to frame the whole lace on a velvet background? This would be the perfect gift! ... The possibilities are endless! By doing the borders, you learn how to do a combination of Filet Guipure stitches, integrating in this traditional technique some modern fancy yarn. Kit fee: \$10.00.

Kit fee: \$10.00 includes pattern with the path & prints, filet net 5, embroidery frame (12" x 12"), thumbtacks to stretch your netting, a filet needle, and grams pearled cotton DMC white. Bring these items from home: a short blunt needle (tapestry no. 16 or longer with a smaller eye and blunt), a dark-colored face towel or fabric (12x12, no prints), small scissors, reading glasses if required, pencil B or HB, eraser, notepad, a metal spoon to push and pull the thumbtacks (no hammer or screwdriver please).
