### **Tape Lace from Lepoglava**

24-hour class

Teacher: Hanneke Troost

This tape lace comes from Lepoglava, a small town in Croatia. It consists of tapes, moving up on one side, coming down on the other side and being sewn together in the middle. One side is made in linen stitches, the second side is made in half stitches. The turning points are round tops, made in half stitches. The outer edge of the half stitch parts are made by a short plait. The tapes can form all kinds of patterns. Insight is needed to make this type of lace. Knowledge of Duchesse lace is recommended.

Materials needed: 17-20" (45-50 cm) pillow, scissors, self-adhesive plastic, Egyptian cotton 60/2 or 70/2, 8 pairs of bobbins wound in pairs with 60 inches (150 cm) per bobbin, Duchesse pins, Duchesse crochet hook.
