### **Milanese Lace-All levels (AM)**

12-hour class

Milanese Lace is characterized by special decorative stitches that become integral features of each design. The creative nature of this type of lace makes it suitable for both traditional and contemporary interpretation. Instruction will cover all levels of Milanese techniques. Students will be given the option of using colored threads to make their own unique pieces from the selected patterns. Both 2-D and 3-D project choices will be offered for the intermediate and advanced levels. Each student choosing a 3-D project will need to purchase a wire kit costing \$10 payable to Louise at convention.

Materials needed: 20" cookie pillow, 12-19 pairs of square or continental bobbins (Spangled are not recommended), 3-D projects will require one pair to hold wire, Gutermann's silk #100/3 (S303) + metallic threads (Madeira or Balger brand), or Mettler Silk Finish #50/3 cotton, pins size 19 x .55mm or 26 x .55 for general purposes (size 26 x .65mm + 26 x .55mm for 3-D patterns), and other misc. supplies including cover cloths (3) or a circular cover cloth with a central hole, pincushion, separator pins, scissors, wire cutters for 3-D projects, pricking supplies (card, contact paper, pricker), pin pusher/lifter, crochet hook size 14 or 15 - or lazy maid for sewings.
