Russian Tape Lace (PM)

12-hour class

This tape lace is originally from Vologda, Russia. The tape can be worked with cloth stitch and/cloth stitch and whole stitch. There can be a decorative stitch in the middle. The fillings are made with the runners (workers) and the passive pair from the tape. It can be for beginners and advanced lace makers.

Materials needed: cookie or block pillow, 20 pairs of bobbins, pins, crochet hook, pricking card, sticky plastic, linen thread 50/2 or 40/2, DMC or Venus tatting thread, gimp (DMC perle cotton 5 or 3, or Madiera Nora crochet cotton). Lia will bring some gimp threads.
