Lace Crossings

3-hour class

This class can be done with a guipure pattern or with a 17th century plaited lace. The students learn the techniques that can be used in all crossings. It can be done by coloring in diagrams of vertical and horizontal crossings and by making a lace pattern with crossings afterwards. This can be a theory class only or students may bring a pillow to work the actual crossings.

Students need colored pencils or fine liners and when they want to make the lace they also need to bring a pillow, bobbins, pins, some reels of colored tatting thread, and other usual lacemaking tools.
